IMPORTANT INFORMATION SHEET

OUR LANDLORD

As reflected in our name, Trinity College is the landlord of Trinity College Tennis Club. We carry the name of the College, and it's important to them and to us. Not so evident is the fact that our sitting area is located directly below the drawing room of the Dean of Women's residence. In the interest of courtesy, let's ensure she is not obliged to overhear our conversations. And, to be perfectly clear, any tennis ball that flies over the fence of St. Hilda's College is OUT OF BOUNDS. Please do not attempt to climb the fence or knock on the door or pursue some other means of retrieving it.

THE CHANGING ROOM

We are privileged to have the use of facilities in the basement of St. Hilda's College. There are two washrooms, two showers, and changing conveniences. There is also a storage room where we keep many of the items that make for a pleasant tennis season (food supplies, serving dishes, maintenance equipment, etc.). This is all compliments of St. Hilda's College – no charge. Please keep the premises tidy.

THE HUT

Most of our chairs, benches, and a variety of other equipment is stored in the hut for the considerate user of members on the premises. We are all expected to assist in taking out chairs and other items as needed, and putting them back in the hut as necessary. Please keep the grounds tidy and free of litter.

LOCKING UP RESPONSIBILITIES

Every member has the responsibility for locking up and ensuring that all club property is secure. Whatever the time of day, the gate to the courts must be locked by the last member to leave the premises. No non-member may be left within the courts' gate when the last member leaves.

KEYS

During the "transitional" months of May and September, where we share the courts with Trinity College students (with no charge to the students), the lock on the courts is a Trinity College lock — the College has kindly provided us with a copy of this key, which is in the hut. During the summer season (June–August), where Trinity students are invited to join the club at a greatly reduced fee, we put our own lock on the gates, the combination to which you have been provided.

GUESTS

Club members may bring guests to play for a fee of \$10, which allows the guest all-day access to the courts (subject to the same rules as the members).

NON-MEMBERS

If you are playing on the courts and a person who does not have a TCTC shoe tag attempts to play, it is your responsibility to advise him or her that this is a private club. It is up to you whether you wish to sponsor this person as a guest, and collect the guest fee (all guest fees are recorded in the black book on the filing table in the hut; you can provide the fees to the court steward or court monitor later). **Should the person refuse to leave, do not attempt a confrontation, but please telephone the Trinity College Porter at St. Hilda's College (our next door neighbour) at 416.978.2522, ext. 2012** (this number is also posted above the clubhouse phone) and advise them of the situation. They will determine how best to respond to the situation.
